2) Chief Armstrong indicated in his Report that the FDAC is in the process of updating the County Fire Master Plan and is soliciting public comment. There is no information on the County Fire Dept. website regaring this.

3) According to Supervisor Friend's statements during Chief Armstrong's Report yesterday, the consolidation issues regarding the LAFCO Sphere and Service Review will be discussed at the August 3 LAFCO meeting. The FDAC should publicly discuss the matter and provide recommendations.

4) Negotiation for new CALFIRE contract with Santa Cruz County. According to the Report yesterday before the Board of Supervisors, negotiations for a new contract are beginning. The current three-year contract is in the second year.

Please place these items on the July 20 FDAC agenda and again allow the public to speak at each agenda item.
