of Calls with No Response from CO29: 3

Nature of No-Response calls: No one available. All three happened to be at the fringes of our response area, and two were in Santa Clara County. One T/C at Bear Creek x 35, one T/C at Redwood Gluch x Hwy 9, one false alarm on Sanborn Rd. On two additional calls, we had a single responder for an auto-aid to Santa Clara T/C, so no response to the scene because the auto-aid agreement does not allow it.

Auto Aid: 18 of the 48 calls (30%) were auto-aid to Santa Clara or San Mateo. Most of the San Mateo calls turn into station coverage when there's only 1 engine at Saratoga Summit

Notable Calls

- Fully involved vehicle fire in Las Cumbres, contained to the vehicle. Difficult to control due to split fuel tank.
- A medical (with staging for violence involved) where the suspect's vehicle ended up in front of E2911 for a time until it was boxed in by law enforcement.

General Information

Apparatus Status/Movement: WT2951 and E2936 had full yearly service. E2911 service (which it desperately needs) was delayed multiple times, was eventually taken to Central Shop on 7/10. Looks like it has to go to Cummins for some engine work. E2936 was staffed by CZU for a few weeks.

Training; Recent/Upcoming/Needs/of Note: Wildland training in late June with FC Sutter on his last shift. Some familiarization with a new "Terra Tamer" wheel and split-apart litter.

Station Programs: Still researching stairs to replace a ladder for attic access at station 29.

Recruiting Prospects: We have been approached by a recent graduate from Allan Hancock College's Fire Academy (also has an EMT) who is moving to the area – we might be able to scoop him up for the cost of an interview, livescan, and physical. For 2025, at least 1 if not both of our EMRs may seek to become FF. There's some potential for a total of 4 candidates, but we'll see.

Recent/Upcoming Community Events: E2911 led out the July 4th Las Cumbres parade, followed by an open house (with free ice cream) at the station. We ran a recruiting presentation with 5 residents in attendance. Sometime in August, we'll be helping out the South Skyline Emergency Preparedness Organization with their "first arrivers" training.
